

## Online Resource Review Assignment

*This is the final assignment in a class about ministry resources. Before class, students read three articles, each about a different ministry topic. During class, three experts came in and shared various resources. Then, students were asked to read and review two resources:*

AFTER CLASS: This is a two-step assignment.

STEP 1 (40 points) : Choose TWO (2) resources from the class presenters' lists. Create a social media-style review of each resource and post them here by 5pm Thursday 4/4.

STEP 2 (10 points) : Choose two reviews from this thread and post a 2-3 sentence response to each of them by Noon, Saturday 4/6.

This is a creative assignment. Please push yourself to try something new (see below for examples and suggestions).

Each review must answer the following questions:

- What is it? (Content)
- What need does the resource meet? (Relevance)
- Who could use the resource?
- Would you recommend it? (Would you use it yourself?)

Possible formats for your review:

- 1-2 minute video, produced on a smart phone or computer.
- Yelp-style review (see example below) created with a user-friendly, free graphic design application [Canva](#), PowerPoint, Microsoft Word, or similar application.
